

## STEPS TO THE ALTAR



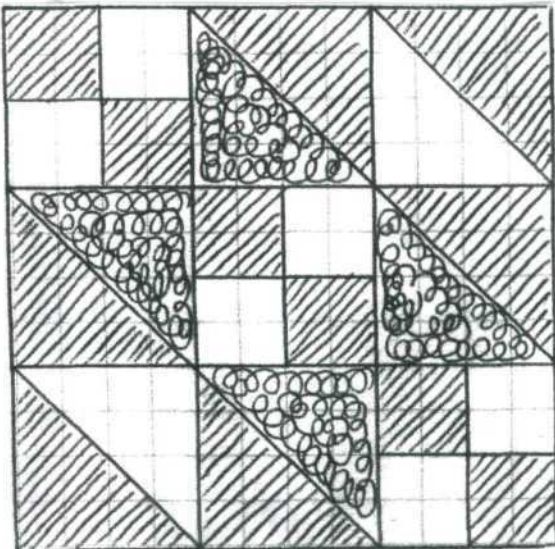
**Black Solid**



**Dark Burgundy Print**



**Medium Dusty Rose Print**



**This block should measure 15 1/2" and will finish as a 15" block when stitched into a quilt.**

**From the black solid you need to cut  
2 - 5 7/8" squares**

**From the dark burgundy print you need to cut  
3 - 5 7/8" squares  
6 - 3" squares**

**From the medium dusty rose print you need to cut  
1 - 5 7/8" squares  
6 - 3" squares**

**Pair the 2 - 5 7/8" black squares with 2 - 5 7/8" burgundy squares, right sides together.  
Draw a diagonal line on the back of the burgundy squares.  
Stitch 1/4" on each side of the line.  
Cut on line.  
You should have 4 black/burgundy units.**

**Pair 1 - 5 7/8" burgundy square with the 5 7/8" dusty rose square, right sides together.  
Draw a diagonal line on the back of the rose square.  
Stitch 1/4" on each side of the line.  
Cut on line.  
You should have 2 burgundy/dusty rose units.**

**Stitch the 6 burgundy 3" squares to the 6 dusty rose 3" squares.  
Then stitch those units into 3 four-patch units using the picture as a guide.**

**Stitch your pieces into rows according to the picture.  
Now stitch the rows together to finish the block.**
