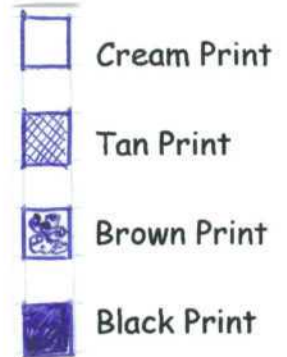


JACOB'S LADDER



- From the cream print you need to cut 10 - 2 1/2" squares.
- From the brown print you need to cut 10 - 2 1/2" squares.
- From the tan print you need to cut 2 - 4 7/8" squares.
- From the black print you need to cut 2 - 4 7/8" squares.
  
- Pair the tan 4 7/8" sqs with the black 4 7/8" sqs right sides together.
- Draw a diagonal line on the back of the tan squares.
- Stitch 1/4" on each side of the diagonal line. Cut on diagonal line, press open.
- You should have 4 tan/black units.
  
- Pair the cream 2 1/2" sqs with the brown 2 1/2" sqs and stitch together.
- You should have 10 cream/brown units.
  
- Stitch the cream/brown units together to make five 4-patch units.
  
- Now stitch the 4-patch units and the tan/black 1/2 square triangle units together in rows according to above picture.
- Then stitch the rows together to make the block.
  
- Your block should measure 12 1/2" and will finish as a 12" block when stitched into a quilt.
