

CARD TRICKS



Green Print



Black Print



Gold Print



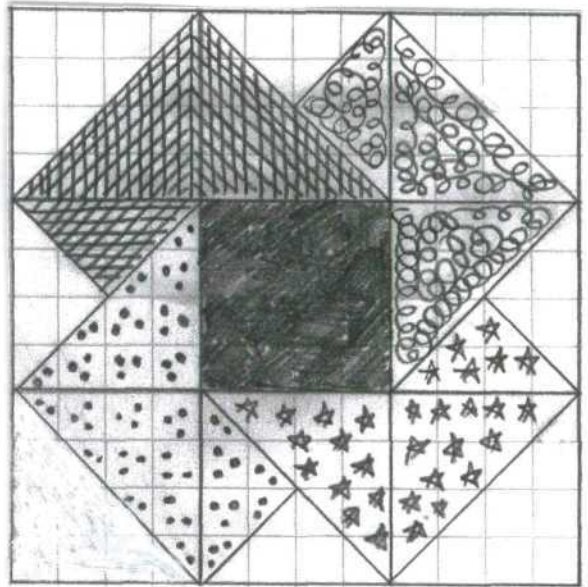
Red Print



Cream Print



Blue Print



This block should measure 15 1/2" and will finish as a 15" block when stitched into a quilt.

From the black print you need to cut
1 - 5 1/2" square

From the red, blue, green and gold you need to cut
1 - 5 7/8" square
1 triangle from template

From the cream print you need to cut
2 - 5 7/8" squares
4 triangles from template

Take all of the 5 7/8" squares and cut them in half on the diagonal (red, blue, green gold and cream)
*****DO NOT CUT THE BLACK SQUARE*****

Pair the larger cream triangles with 1 each of the larger red, blue, green and gold triangles, right sides together.

Stitch the pairs together along the long side of the triangle using a 1/4" seam.
These will be the corner units of your block.

Pair the smaller cream triangles with the smaller triangles of red, blue, green and gold, right sides together.

Stitch them along a short edge using the picture as a guide.

The next step sounds a bit tricky...but you can do it!

Pair the following...

blue/cream triangle unit with large gold triangle
gold/cream triangle unit with large green triangle
green/cream triangle unit with large red triangle
red/cream triangle unit with large blue triangle

} right sides together

Stitch together along the long edge using 1/4" seam.

You should now have all square units.

Stitch the units together in rows **CAREFULLY** using picture as a guide.

Stitch rows together to finish the block.

CONGRATULATIONS! That was a tricky one!!
