



MAPLE LEAF



From the light blue print you need to cut
 2 4 1/2" squares
 2 4 7/8" squares

From your fall color you need to cut
 3 4 1/2" squares
 2 4 7/8" squares

Bias strip...attached

Applique the bias strip diagonally onto one of the light blue 4 1/2" squares.
 Pair the fall color 4 7/8" squares with the light blue 4 7/8" squares, right sides together.

Draw a diagonal line on the back of the light blue squares.

Stitch 1/4" on each side of the diagonal line.

Cut on diagonal line and press open.

You should have four light blue/fall color units.

Stitch your pieces into rows according to above picture.

Stitch your rows together to finish the block.

Your block should measure 12 1/2" and will finish to a 12" square when stitched into a quilt.
