



JACK IN THE BOX



Cream Print

Med or Dark Print
of your choice

- From the cream print you need to cut 8 - $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
- From your medium or dark print you need to cut 8 - $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
- Draw a diagonal line on the back of the cream squares.
- Pair the cream squares with your fabric choice squares right sides together.
- Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the diagonal line. Cut on line. You should have 16 cream/dark print units. Press them open.
- Now stitch these units together in rows according to the picture.
- Then stitch the rows together according to picture to make the block.
- Your block should measure $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " to finish as a 12" block when stitched into a quilt.
