CREAM PRINT



TAN OR LT BROWN PRINT



YOUR CHOICE OF PRINT  
FOR THE "THREAD" COLOR

From the cream print you need to cut

2 - 4 7/8" squares

2 - 4 1/2" squares

From the tan print you need to cut

2 - 4 7/8" squares

2 - 4 1/2" squares

From your "thread" print choice you need to cut

1 - 4 1/2" square

- Pair the 4 7/8" cream squares with the 4 7/8" tan squares right sides together.
- Draw a diagonal line on the back of the cream squares
- Stitch 1/4" on each side of the line.
- Cut on line.
- You should have 4 cream/tan units. Press them open.
- Now piece together in rows according to above picture, making sure that your corners are going in the right direction.
- Stitch rows together to finish the block.
- Your block should measure 12 1/2" and will finish as a 12" block when stitched into a quilt.
