Shadow Block

For each block cut...

White fabric:

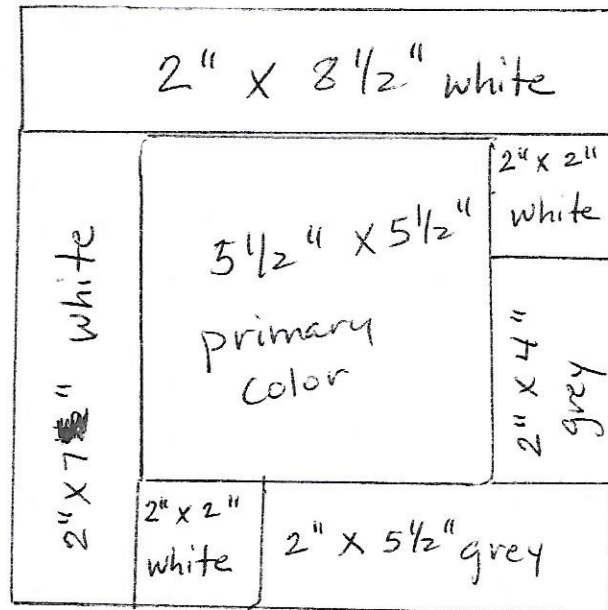
- (2) 2" squares
- (1) 2" X 7" strip
- (1) 2" X 8 1/2" strip

Grey fabric:

- (1) 2" X 4" med/dark grey
- (1) 2" X 5 1/2" med/dark grey

Primary Color – solid or reads as solid (any color appropriate for a boy)

- 5 1/2" square



Stitch the 2" white squares to the two grey strips. Press. You will then have one strip that is 5 1/2 inches long, and one strip that is 7 inches long.

Starting on one side of the 5 1/2" primary color square (and going around the square in a clockwise motion), stitch the 5 1/2 inch white/grey strip to the right side of the color square with the white piece at the top. Press. Then sew the 7 inch white/grey strip to the bottom of the color square with the white piece on the left. Press. Next sew the 7 inch white strip to the left side of the square (press) and the 8 1/2 inch white strip to the top of the color square. Press.

Your block should measure 8 1/2" square and the grey strips should be in the lower right hand corner.
